


# Our network



### How to read this map

Here's your key to the lines and symbols used on this map

- Baidon: Northern trains on this line usually stop here
- Buxton: Northern trains usually start or finish at stations where the circles are filled in
- Clifton: Northern trains on this line don't usually stop here, but may call additionally at this station at peak times
- Castleford: this is an interchange station where you can change easily between two or more lines
- Station Name: connections are available here for Merseyrail trains, Bee Network trams, Tyne & Wear Metro trains, or Supertram
- : this route is served by Northern trains
- - -: this line has a limited Northern service, but more frequent trains may be available with other operators
- Penrith: Northern trains do not stop here, but this is a key station on a busy line where lots of other trains stop
- Malton: no Northern trains stop here, but other operators serve this station
